PROPERTY TAX, RENT REBATE APPLICATION DEADLINE FAST APPROACHING

The June 30 application deadline for the state's 2023 Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program is coming soon.

This year, more Pennsylvanians who are 65 or older, widows and widowers 50 years or older, and those 18 years or older with disabilities will be eligible to receive a rebate on the property taxes and rent paid last year. With Act 7 of 2023, the General Assembly passed the first expansion in 20 years with provisions for cost-of-living adjustments each year, increasing the income limits this year to \$45,000 and the maximum rebate to \$1,000. Applicants are encouraged to apply early. The Department of Revenue will start sending payments July 1.

GRANTS AWARDED IN 46TH DISTRICT

So far this year, a number of grants have been awarded in the 46th Legislative District with money appropriated through legislation I supported. These grants include:

- **\$750,000** to the South Fayette Library from a Keystone Public Library Facilities grant to rehabilitate public library facilities.
- **\$258,750** to Oakdale from the Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund for a new roof system on the borough's community center.
- **\$242,250** to McDonald Borough from the Greenway, Trails and Recreation Program to install restrooms at Heritage Park that comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- **\$6,764** to Fort Cherry School District from a Food Service Equipment grant to purchase new food service equipment for its cafeterias.
