South Fayette Picked for Pilot Program Spearheaded by Ortitay

South Fayette Township School District was chosen as one of 10 school districts to participate in the Disability Inclusive Curriculum Pilot Program, which was created under legislation I authored that was signed into law last year.

The program teaches students in kindergarten through 12th grade about the political, economic and social contributions of individuals with disabilities. It will impact the overall culture and environment of schools by reducing the stigma of disability by including disability as a part of a school-wide strategic plan. In addition, the pilot program includes grant funding of up to \$10,000 per year to each district for three years.

To further advance inclusivity, the Pennsylvania Department of Education announced it will house a disability inclusion toolkit on its Standards Aligned System to help support school entities across the state to infuse disability inclusive curriculum into their existing curricula. The toolkit resources are inclusive of all age/grade levels and include sample lesson plans, professional development offerings/opportunities, ideas for implementing a disability inclusive curriculum, disability-led organizational contacts, and other resources.

Small Business Assistance Available in My District Office

A representative from the University of Pittsburgh Small Business Development Center (SBDC) is available to provide free assistance to small business owners and entrepreneurs the first Monday of each month in my South Fayette district office.
